This report summarizes CBO's estimates of budget authority that stems from laws enacted since 2000 that provide supplemental discretionary appropriations. The "Request" columns reflect CBO's estimates for requests transmitted to the Congress by the President, provided that they contained legislative text. The "Enacted" columns reflect the estimates that CBO prepared when legislation to provide supplemental appropriations was passed by the Congress. Those estimates measured the cost of legislation relative to the baseline projections used for budget enforcement by the House and Senate Committees on the Budget at the time the legislation was considered.
