Dear Mr. Chairman:

This letter corrects information that was provided to you yesterday concerning the estimated cost of the Chairman's mark for the 2007 farm bill. The information provided yesterday incorrectly omitted part of the cost of title II of that legislation.

Based on a preliminary review of the Chairman's mark of the 2007 farm bill posted on the committee's Web site on July 13, 2007, CBO estimates that enactment of the draft legislation would increase direct spending relative to the March 2007 baseline by \$4.4 billion in budget authority and \$2.1 billion in outlays over the 2008-2012 period and by \$6.9 billion in budget authority and \$1.7 billion in outlays over the 2008-2017 period. The direct spending effects of the legislation are summarized in Table 1. (Those estimates exclude the costs of sections 4003 and 4006, which CBO has not yet estimated.) The legislation would also result in an additional \$20 million in revenues over the 2008-2017 period.

In addition, enactment of the Chairman's mark would affect spending subject to appropriation action. However, CBO has not completed an estimate of the potential discretionary costs of the act.

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Finally, CBO has completed a preliminary estimate of the en bloc amendment to the Chairman's mark, posted on the committee's Web site on July 13, 2007. We estimate that amendment would add \$16.5 billion over the 2008-2012 period and \$34.4 billion over the 2008-2017 period to direct spending outlays under the Chairman's mark (see Table 2).

Together, the two pieces of legislation would result in direct spending outlays totaling \$299 billion over the 2008-2012 period and \$633 billion over the 2008-2017 period; relative to CBO's March 2007 baseline projections, those amounts represent increases of \$18.6 billion over the 2008-2012 period and \$36.0 billion over the 2008-2017 period.
