## H.R. 592

## An act to designate a portion of Gateway National Recreation Area as World War Veterans Park at Miller Field

As ordered reported by the Senate Committee on Energy and Natural Resources on October 20, 1999

H.R. 592 would designate a portion of the Gateway National Recreation Area (currently known as Miller Field) as the World War Veterans Park at Miller Field.

CBO estimates that implementing H.R. 592 would have no significant impact on the federal budget. The act would not affect direct spending or receipts; therefore, pay-as-you-go procedures would not apply. H.R. 592 contains no intergovernmental or private-sector mandates as defined in the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act and would have no significant impact on the budgets of state, local, or tribal governments.

On June 11, 1999, CBO prepared a cost estimate for H.R. 592 as ordered reported by the House Committee on Resources on June 9, 1999. The two versions of the legislation are identical, as are the cost estimates.
