There were no supplemental appropriations enacted in FY 2011 or FY 2012.

1. Provided \$442 million for FEMA disaster relief. The President's request is shown with P.L.108-69.
2. The President requested these funds for FY 2005. For comparison purposes, they are shown in FY 2004.
3. The President requested \$10.276 billion for FY 2004 and \$1.579 billion in FY 2005. For comparison purposes all of the request is shown in FY 2005.
4. P.L.109-174 provided a transfer from FEMA disaster relief (originally provided in P.L.109-62) to the SBA disaster loan program in the amount of \$712 million. No new budget authority was provided. The President requested \$1.254 billion for the disaster loan program.
5. This act expanded the scope of an existing appropriated entitlement (compensation for veterans affected by Agent Orange). The President requested \$13,377 billion; CBO estimated \$3,350 million was needed for 2010.
6. In this legislation, Congress did not consider \$5,360 million of funds requested by the President's including those for settlement payments (Cobell, Pigford), certain Gulf Coast oil spill proposals, and border security.
7. This act provided \$129 million in FY 2010 for salaries and expenses of the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office. It also rescinded \$129 million from the FY 2010 appropriation for Periodic Censuses and Programs.
