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- a. S. 482 would amend the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 to require electronic filing of Senate campaign reports. Enacting the legislation could affect federal revenues by increasing the collection of fines for violations of the law. A portion of such revenues would be available for spending. CBO estimates that any additional revenues and direct spending under the legislation would be insignificant because of the small number of anticipated violations.
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
