Reduce Agricultural Subsidies. Direct payments to producers (fixed annual payments for program crops and peanuts based on historical acres and yields) would be eliminated beginning with the 2013 crop, assuming authority for these payments is repealed in the next farm bill. Savings from eliminating direct payments would be offset by increased outlays for both price- (countercyclical) and revenue- (ACRE) based programs. The proposal would also extend agricultural disaster assistance programs similar to the Supplemental Revenue Assistance Programs in Elifor crops and livestock for the 2013-2017 fiscal years.

Programmatic Changes to Crop Insurance. CBO assumes enactment would not be before the contract change date for fall planted 2013 crops or the beginning of the 2013 reinsurance year and thus would become effective for the 2014 crops.

Better Target Conservation Spending. Total acreage in the Conservation Reserve Program would be reduced to 30 million acres (from the existing cap of 32 million) beginning in 2013, assuming the CRP is reauthorized in the next farm bill. The proposal would also reduce annual funding for the Environmental Quality Incentives Program by \$100 million (from authorized level of \$1.750 billion per year), beginning in 2013. Outyear Mandatory Effects of Discretionary changes to CSP. CBO includes the savings from the outyear effects of discretionary changes to the Conservation Stewardship Program (limit enrollment in 2013 to 12,009,368 acres) as a discretionary change in mandatory programs instead of as a mandatory proposal.

User Fees. CBO considers mandatory user fees to be taxes (additional revenues), subject to an annual percentage offset. The NRCS fee proposal would be voluntary and, hence, would be offsetting collections. In this table, a negative number for a tax indicates an increase in revenue/decrease in the deficit.
