H.R. 1069 would require the Office of Clean Energy Demonstrations within the Department of Energy to report semiannually to the Congress on the status of various demonstration projects.

Based on the cost of similar activities, CBO estimates that implementing the bill would cost \$1 million over the 2024-2028 period; such spending would be subject to the availability of appropriated funds.
